1 NAME OF TOURNAMENT 7. PingPongParkinson World Championship 2026 Hanover

2 ELIGIBILITY The championship is open to all members of PingPongParkinson International diagnosed with Parkinson. The first date of Parkinson diagnosis confirmed by a doctor must be stated upon registration. If proof of diagnosis has yet to be provided, the players concerned will be asked to do so after registration.

3 MEMBERSHIP You are automatically member of PPP International if you are member of an official national PPP organization (Australia, Brazil, Croatia, France, Germany, Israel, Italy, Malta, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Slovenia, Switzerland, USA). Otherwise PPP International membership for one year must be acquired by paying an extra membership fee of € 12,00.

9 COMPETITIONS	Men's Singles, Women's Singles, Men's Doubles, Women's Doubles, Mixed Doubles
10 CLASSES	In each competition three classes 1, 2 and 3 are played.
11 CLASSIFICATION	<p>Singles Classification is based on table tennis playing strength. For new players it is based on the self-assessment of the participant, with regard to their table tennis experience and any known results. The new players concerned will be asked about their assessment after registration. Anyone who does not provide information about their table tennis skills in time will be placed in Class 1. The final decision will be made by the organizer.</p> <p>For each player the allocation to the class for singles (basic class) will be made by the tournament management and will be published up to 06 Sep 2026, so no player must provide a class at the entry process. Requests to play singles in a higher class can be made up to 16 Sep 2026 by e-mail.</p> <p>Doubles Each pair plays in the class of the player with the higher singles basic class. A desired higher classification for singles has no effect on the classification in doubles and mixed.</p> <p>The pairs for doubles and mixed can only be registered based on the final entries and the decision of the basic class of each player for singles in the time from 06 through 16 Sep 2026. After that new pairs can only be registered at the partner market during the accreditation in Hanover.</p>
12 REPRESENTATION	Each player competes for the country of their nationality. Players with multiple nationalities may choose one of them for this and subsequent PPP tournaments. Players who have lived for a long time in a country for which they have no nationality but wish to compete for, they may name that country for this and subsequent PPP tournaments after registration informal.

13 PLAYING SYSTEM

Singles	Preliminary round in groups of preferably six players, each playing against each other. First three players will advance to the main round, the others to the consolation round. The main round and the consolation round will be played in a single elimination system.
Doubles	Preliminary round in groups of preferably four pairs, each playing against each other. First and second place will advance to the main round, the others to the consolation round. The main round and the consolation round will be played in a single elimination system.

14 GAMES

All matches will be best of five games.

16 LIMIT OF PLAYERS

The maximum number of players who can be registered is 600. Players will be registered in order of the date their payment has been made. In case of cancellations, no other players can be registered.

17 FORM OF ENTRY

Players must register on <https://www.ttm.co.at/pppwc2026/register>. Registration is neither planned nor required for accompanying persons.

18 ENTRY DATES

Registration will be open from 19 Feb 2026 to 15 Aug 2026. The registration can be closed early in case of overbooking. The registration is only valid if the entry fee has been transferred. Entries on FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED basis (payments), but please note: fees are non-refundable except with a medical certificate in case of illness.

19 ENTRY FEE

€ 95,00

This entry fee applies for all players. Those, who have a pre-registration from 2025, will be refunded their 20 € fee during the accreditation in Hanover in cash.

20 PRE-REGISTRATION

For each player it is possible to secure their place in the PPP World Championship 2027 in Magglingen/ Switzerland/12 -17 Oct 2027 early by paying the amount of € 20 per tournament with the payment for Hanover. This amount of € 20 will be credited towards the entry fee for 2027. It will be converted into a donation for PPP International if the entry for the tournament is waived at a later date.

27 AWARDS

Medals for the winners, runners up and semi-finalists in main round. Gifts for the winners and runners up in consolation round.

28 RULES

The tournament will be played according to the rules of the ITTF, with the announced modifications for PwP, see pppwc.org.
The tournament management reserves the right to make changes.

29 FAIR PLAY RULES

In due course, detailed fair play rules for participants and spectators will be announced as a binding part of the tournament concept. Failure to comply will result in exclusion from the tournament. This also applies to spectators.

30 UMPIRING

Participation is only possible for players who confirm that they are able to umpire a table tennis match and will do so upon request. Failure to comply will result in exclusion from the tournament.

31 PRIVACY POLICY

The player further agrees that the data stated in their registration, the photos, film recordings and interviews in connection with their participation in the tournament may be used in radio, television, internet, newspaper, advertising, books, photomechanical reproductions (films, video cassettes, etc.) without any claim to remuneration on their part.

32 FIRST AID

The presence of trained professionals guarantees the players physical wellbeing.

33 INSURANCE

By entering the event, each participant must ensure that he or she has sufficient medical, travel, and other insurance. During registration, all foreign participants have the opportunity to take out insurance coverage. This includes health, accident, and liability insurance for the period from September 24 through October 01, 2026. The total fee for this insurance coverage is € 15.00.
